- Already have a clear diagnosis of Alzheimer's disease or another dementia
- Are living in a skilled nursing or other extended care facility
- Have a history of traumatic brain injury (TBI)
- Are younger than 50

# Referral Process for Georgia Memory Net MAC and Telehealth Visits

### STEP 1: When to Refer a Patient to Georgia Memory Net

The patient is seen by their primary care provider (PCP), and it is determined that the patient would benefit from further testing and the need for a diagnosis.

### **STEP 2: Recommended Attachments**

Recommended Attachments:

- Last medical note with the main cognitive problem
- List of active medications

Other Attachments (if available):

- Any cognitive testing that was done and is not included in the past medical note
- · Recent labs and results of neuroimaging if done

### **STEP 3: Complete this Referral Form**

Based on the patient's need, follow the instructions for either <u>Option 1</u> or <u>Option 2</u> below. A list of Memory Assessment Clinics (MACs) and Department of Public Health (DPH) Telehealth sites can be found on the next page.

#### Option 1: Referral to a MAC

Complete this referral form and fax it, along with the recommended attachments, to the MAC convenient to your patient. No additional steps are needed by the PCP. When the MAC receives the completed referral form, they will contact the patient directly to schedule the initial appointment.

### **Option 2: Referral to a DPH Telehealth Site:**

Patients who are not able to travel the full distance to a MAC and who are not able to complete a telehealth visit from home have the option to visit a local DPH site in some areas of the state. Complete this referral form and fax it, along with the recommended attachments, to the DPH site selected by the patient. No additional steps are needed by the PCP. Upon receipt, the completed referral form will be forwarded to the appropriate MAC and the patient will be contacted directly to schedule the initial appointment.
